The Especially Merciful - Specifically merciful to the believers. Forgiveness extending into the Hereafter is a part of this mercy. It is verbal, indicating what Allah does and describing His act of showing and implementing mercy. الملك The Sovereign and Owner of everything in existence. القُدّوس The Pure - i.e., transcendent above any aspect belonging to His creation. Also, the possessor and grantor of blessings. Perfection - Literally, free from any imperfection. Also, soundness and peace. المُؤمِن The Grantor of Security and safety, i.e., reassurance that His promise is always fulfilled. Also, He who bestows faith. The Overseer - i.e., He who observes, guards and protects. Also, the Criterion. العَزيز The Exalted in Might - Honored for absolute power associated with wisdom and justice. الحُيّار The Compeller - Whose irresistible force is without limitation; the one above all things who compels creation to be as He wills it. Also, the Amender or the Rectifier who repairs, restores, completes or sets something right again out of His mercy. The Superior - Supreme, complete and perfect in His essence, attributes and actions. الخالق The Creator - i.e., He who destined existence for His creation. البارئ The Producer - He who brings His creation into existence. The Fashioner - He who gives every creation its particular form. الغَفَّار The Perpetual Forgiver who continually conceals sins and faults. القُهَّار The Prevailing - The one who subdues doubts and false arguments with clear evidences and who subdues and imposes His will upon all of creation. الوَهَّاب The Bestower - He who grants all provisions, favors and blessings الرَّزُّاق The Constant Provider - He who provides everything required by His creations during their decreed existence. His provision includes guidance.

He Who Decides - Literally, the Opener - who decides and lays open all matters in truth and justice, and who opens the way to victory, success, relief, knowledge and

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understanding.

الحَليم	The Forbearing - He who overlooks many violations, postpones punishment with purposeful deliberation and grants opportunity for repentance and rectification, having the power to punish while refraining from it
العَظيم	The Most Great - He whose greatness is unlimited, beyond description or imagination
الغَفور	The Forgiving - He who conceals sins and faults
الشَّكور	The Appreciative - He who gives much in return for little and multiplies rewards
العَليّ	The Most High - Above all of His creations and superior to them in essence, rank and position

المَتين	The Firm - Whose strength is not weakened or compromised
الوَليّ	The Ally - The patron, supporter, benefactor, guardian, protector, defender, caretaker
الحَميد	The Praiseworthy - Due to His perfection in every way

المُبْدِئ	The Initiator - He who begins creation from nothing
المُعيد	The Repeater - He who repeats and renews creation

المُحْيي	The Giver of Life - He who enables life and who causes the soul to enter the body
المُميت	The Cause of Death - He who decreed death and imposes it on His creations
الحَيّ	The Ever-Living - Whose life is perfect, complete and eternal, without beginning or end, and from whom all created life is derived
القَيُّوم	The Self-Sustaining - The Lord and Master, dependent on none for His existence while being the sustainer and administrator of all created existence
الواجِد	The Self-Existent who needs nothing but favors us with existence. Also, the Perceiver
الماجِد	The Honorable - Whose essential nature is glorious, honorable, and generous
الواحِد	The One - Single, individual and unique in His essence, attributes and deeds
الأَحَد	The One - Alone, without another, indivisible with absolute and permanent unity and distinct from all else, the one and only true deity
الصَّمَد	The Eternal - The absolute and essential, perfect and complete, self-sufficient and sufficient for the needs of all. He who is eternally and constantly required and sought out, to whom alone all matters are referred and will ultimately return.

المُنتَقِم	The Exactor of Retribution - He who punishes those deserving of it after having given them adequate warnings, reprieves and opportunities for repentance	
ذو انتقام	Owner of retribution - on behalf of His oppressed servants until they are satisfied	
العَفُوّ	The Pardoning - Literally, He who erases and removes sins completely, leaving no trace of them in the record of deeds	
الرَّؤوف	The Kind, Caring - extremely merciful to His servants in spite of their sins

الباقي	The Ever-Lasting, remaining after all else perishes, whose non-existence is impossible	
الوارِث	The Inheritor - He who lives on, prevails and repossesses all things	
الرَّشيد	The Director to what is righteous, correct and appropriate	
الصَّبُور	The Constantly Patient, who does not hasten to punish wrongdoers but gives them respite
